



Jesus divided Old Testament Law into 2 New Testament categories. We balance the 10 commandments when we ride on these 2 wheels: **Love God** (*No god, no idol, no name, remember the Sabbath*) and **Love One Another** (*honor parents, don't murder, don't commit adultery, don't steal, don't lie, don't covet*). Today we will focus on command # 6: "Do not murder" (Exd 20:13.) Israel understood from creation that humans were made in God's image (Gen 1:25-27; 4:6-9, 16).



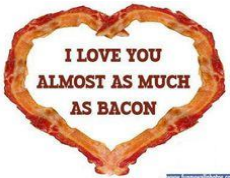
**God gave Israel the law "Do not murder," so they would:**

- 1. R \_\_\_\_\_ life as divinely given. Genesis 2:7
- 2. R \_\_\_\_\_ justice or convenience by own hand. Proverbs 6:17  
*-Exodus 21:12-14*
- 3. R \_\_\_\_\_ God as author of life and death. Exodus 21:22-25  
*-1 Samuel 2:6*  
*-Matthew 5:21-22*



**God gave us the New Testament law "Do not murder" for the same 3 reasons:**

- 1. R \_\_\_\_\_ life as divinely given. 1 John 3:15-18  
*-Genesis 9:3*  
*-Mark 7:18-19*  
*-1 Timothy 4:2-5*
- 2. R \_\_\_\_\_ justice or convenience by own hand. Romans 13:3-4
- 3. R \_\_\_\_\_ God as author of life and death. Psalm 139:16  
*-Romans 13:3-4*  
*-Ezekiel 18:23*  
*-Psalm 139:13-14*
