Why do we work hard to communicate truth in memorable way (2 Timothy 4:3-4)? Our world and sadly the church is not always interested in Truth.

- Jude 1:3 urges us to *"contend"* for the faith.
- 1 Peter 3:15 says to be ready to defend the reason we have hope.
- St. Augustine says truth is like a lion that will defend itself.

E

Jesus, our Lion from the tribe of Judah has spoken and truth will not return void. Sometimes after a rough week what we really need on Sunday is a reminder that God wants to defend us (Psalm 139:1-5, 13-18, 23-24). Knowing God cares helps us rest in His truth. *Truth can hurt, but not telling the truth can hurt even more*. Thus we come to the 9<sup>th</sup> commandment in our sermon series (Exodus 20:16). To put on love for one another requires us to not lie to one another.
